Fundraising

QParents Coming to Picnic Creek in 2022

We are excited to share that in 2022 Picnic Creek will be offering families the opportunity to access a secure portal, QParents, that will give families access to information on Apple or Android devices. This allows families the flexibility to make payments, advise the school of their child's absence, update contact details, view excursion details and access report cards. It provides one access point to all of this information. Each parent is provided a unique identification code and this is the first step to setting up your account. When will I receive my code from the school? QParents is being introduced in January 2022. We are wanting to share information with families now so that you have an opportunity to have all of your questions answered prior to this being launched next year.
